The Masterclass is back and this year we will tackle nerve surgery. This is an excellent opportunity for consultants and very senior trainees with an interest in Nerve Surgery. The course will run in conjunction with the established ICHS course 7.2 (Nerve injury, decompression, pain & anaesthesia) and will cover: Brachial plexus dissection, Nerve transfers (including Oberlin & Bangkok), Tendon transfers for Radial, Median & Ulnar nerves, Nerve grafting using autograft and allograft.

With a faculty to delegate ratio of 1:2, delegates will receive guidance from established nerve surgery experts to allow them perform the above procedures. Pre-course material will be provided in advance to ensure all time is spent in the lab.
