

## **Dr. Peter M. Murray**

Dr. Peter M. Murray is a Magna Cum Laude Chemistry graduate from West Virginia University, Morgantown, WV, USA and was also a distinguished graduate of the United States Air Force ROTC program at West Virginia. He obtained his Doctor of Medicine degree from West Virginia University School of Medicine in 1985, with honors. He was elected to the Phi Beta Kappa and Alpha Omega Alpha honor societies.

He completed a residency in orthopedic surgery at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, Iowa City, Iowa and later a fellowship in hand and microvascular surgery at the Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN.

While on active duty in the United States Air Force he rose to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel and was Chief of Hand and Microvascular Surgery, Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland AFB, San Antonio, TX. He was awarded the Air Force Meritorious Service Medal and the Air Force Commendation Medal.

Dr Murray is consultant in orthopedic surgery at Mayo Clinic, Jacksonville, FL and his clinical and research interests include brachial plexus reconstruction, upper extremity tumor surgery, free-tissue transfer surgery and hand, wrist and elbow arthroplasty. Since 2005, he has held the position of Director for Education.

Dr. Murray is an associate editor for the Journal of Hand Surgery, the Journal of Orthopaedic Trauma and Hand. He has authored over 125 scientific publications.
