We are looking forward to welcoming and hosting you on March 2010 in Paris for the MEGA HAND 2010!

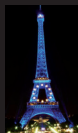

AGING AND REJUVENATION OF THE HAND AND UPPER LIMB: SURGICAL, MEDICAL AND ADJUVANT TREATMENTS

(nails, hand, wrist, forearm, elbow, arm, axilla, shoulder)

PLASTIC RECONSTRUCTIVE AND AESTHETIC SURGERY OF THE HAND AND UPPER LIMB: CONVENTIONAL TECHNIQUES, REFINEMENTS AND INNOVATIONS

The MEGA HAND Symposium being an international meeting, all presentations will be given in English. There will be no simultaneous translation.

CME credits

European and American CME accreditation
